

## PE & Sport Premium Detailed Allocation of Funds 22-23

### Chester School Sports Partnership

- **Total £1,500 includes the following:**
- MEMBER SCHOOLS
- KS1 Multi Skills Festival
- Leadership Programme for primary schools, including Sports Ambassadors Training
- SEN Multi Sports Festival
- Intensive School Swimming Programme for Year 6 pupils
- NGB linked programmes and clear pathways to local clubs
- CPD Teachers Programme throughout the year
- Gifted and Talented Training for KS2 pupils
- Playground Leader Training
- Athlete Visits at selected events
- Pupil Assessment System
- Member Schools meetings and networking
- Annual Sports Award Ceremony

### Sports Coach leading and supporting the teaching of PE

- **Total £3,805 includes the following:**
- 6 hours a week of her full time position in school is dedicated to the teaching of PE in the curriculum including the following:
- A coaching and team teaching model to improve the quality of PE teaching across the school including planning, delivery, resourcing and time management.
- Consistent delivery of high quality PE across Years 4, 5 & 6 showing the progressive development of skills evidenced in the PE Scheme of Work adopted through Edsential.
- Manage a small budget effectively to ensure all resources are used to maximise participation.
- To liaise with other schools and partnerships to ensure Dee Point enters all PE competitions both locally in Blacon Education Village but also within the Chester School Sports Partnership.

### Additional After School Sport provided by CEPD & Wheels Extreme

- **Total £5,850 includes the following:**
- A specialist coaching programme for skateboards, inline skates and scooters each week across Years 3 & 4
- A regular after school coaching sessions 3 times per week in racquet sports, multi skills and Y2 football.

### Swimming in Early Years & Resource Provision

- **Total £8,485 includes the following:**
- weekly 1 hour swimming lessons for the children in the school's complex moderate learning provision.
- 6 x ½ hr a week small group teaching session (1:4) for Nursery children
